NONDEGREE

- A graduate student who has earned a baccalaureate degree or higher who at the present time does not wish to pursue a graduate degree, certificate, or endorsement program.
- May accumulate no more than three (3) graduate courses or nine (9) graduate credits, whichever is less.
- Proof of bachelor's degree (copy of transcript or diploma), if other than from William Paterson University, is required.

POST-MASTER'S

- A graduate student who has earned a master's degree and wishes to undertake further graduate study.
- May take up to thirty (30) credits without enrolling in a graduate degree, certificate, or endorsement program.
- Proof of a master's degree (transcript or diploma), if other than from William Paterson University, is required.
- If you wish to pursue a graduate degree, certificate, or endorsement, you must apply for matriculation and be accepted into a program.

PLEASE NOTE:

Admission into nondegree, post master's categories does not imply eligibility for matriculation or acceptance into any degree or certification program.

Students in these categories are subject to the same academic standards and policies as matriculated students.

The clinical and counseling psychology, communication disorders, and educational leadership programs are not open to nondegree students.

Courses in art, professional counseling, music, and nursing are only available to nondegree students with approval of the appropriate graduate program director.

A non-refundable application fee of \$50 must accompany this application.
