*These are questions you should ask your advisor:*

1. How many credits do I need to graduate for my intended major?<sup>1</sup>
2. How many **earned credits** do I have toward graduation?  
(completed courses with a passing grade)
3. How many **credits** do I have **in progress**? (courses taking in the current semester)
4. What is my anticipated date of graduation based upon the number of credits I usually take?
5. Can I graduate sooner if I take summer (*max 14 credits*) and winter (*max 3 credits*) session courses?
6. With my current GPA, can I handle a shortened semester (*summer*) or online (*winter*) course?
7. What requirements do I still need to take?

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# **Transfer Students and Other Considerations**

## **Transfer Students**

1. What is a good plan for getting all of my course requirements completed?

- Request a final transcript from your previous institution
- Meet your academic advisor to review transferred courses
- Complete the below requirements:
  - Take a Writing Intensive Course #3000+
  - Satisfy the Foreign Language Requirement
  - Complete Major/Minor requirements
  - Maintain a 2.0 overall and major GPA
  - Complete a Total of 120 credits (depending on your program)

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<sup>3</sup> Under the 2008 NJ legislation, students entering WPUNJ with an AA or AS degree (*not including an AAS or AAA*) from a New Jersey community college can waive the University Core Curriculum (UCC) requirements (except you must take one 3000 level Writing Intensive course and the Foreign Language requirement).

<sup>4</sup> Students with an AAS or AAA or transferring from a community college outside of New Jersey must complete the University Core Curriculum ("UCC").
