

Dr. Post has spent most of her extensive career within the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) Division of Science and Research. She is a toxicologist responsible for health effects evaluation and risk assessment of contaminants found in New Jersey's environment. She has made substantial contributions to the risk assessments of many environmental contaminants including per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), also known as "forever chemicals". Dr. Post will discuss her work on PFAS and her career at the NJDEP.
