Standing Charges:

- 3. Inform and educate the University community (including Faculty, Librarians, Professional Staff and Students) regarding new media and technology plans, procedures, issues, and trends (including but not limited to Banner, e-mail and computers).
- 4. Help administrators involved in areas of media and technology identify technological problems and needs, and establish media and technology standards.
- 5. Participate in the University's technological planning process and prioritization of media and technological resources.
- 6. Recommend media and technological initiatives and means for improvement.
- 7. Review media and technology policies and procedures periodically and suggest revisions as needed
