Background Information and Behavioral Description	Provides comprehensive and detailed descriptions in both areas; narrative is well written and grammatically correct	Provides limited information on background, but comprehensive behavioral description; narrative is clearly written with very few grammatical errors	Provides limited information in both areas; narrative is not clear and contains more than 3 grammatical errors
2. Description and Analysis of Performance on Tasks Within Individual Mathematics Strands	Provides thorough description of student's performance and teacher's interventions (including examples) on assessments and learning within content strands; Provides comprehensive, accurate, and detailed analysis and interpretation of meaning of observations reported in terms of specific mathematical competencies; addresses 4 or 5 mathematics strands noted in assignment directions	Provides description of some elements of students' performance and teacher's interventions on assessments (including some examples) and learning within content strands; Provides accurate analysis and interpretation of meaning of observations reported using global mathematical competencies within specific mathematics strands; Addresses at least 3 mathematics strands noted in assignment directions	Provides partial, incomplete, or inaccurate description of all elements of students' performance and teacher's interventions (without examples) on assessments and learning within content strands; Provides inaccurate analysis and interpretation of observations reported within specific mathematics strands; Addresses 2 or fewer specific mathematics strands noted in assignment directions
3. Summary and Recommendations	Provides summary based on all evidence provided in report; includes strengths and weaknesses in each content area; Recommendations are specific, related to report, and include technology resources	Provides summary based on some evidence provided in report; includes strengths and weaknesses in some content areas; Recommendations are specific and related to report	Provides incomplete summary; summary not based on evidence provided in report; does not include both strengths and weaknesses; Recommendations are not specific and not related to report
