

Required Field Experiences

Required each year

- Shadowing principals- 12 hours/ 2 years
- Shadowing vice/assistant principals- 12 hours/ 2 years
- Attending professional development workshops/conferences- 12 hours/ 2 years
- Regularly scheduled meetings with mentor- 30 hours/ 2 years
- Meeting with community-based agencies

Required once in two years

- Leading a professional development program
- Peer Coaching and/or mentoring of new teachers, student teachers, practicum teachers
- Experiences with a business administrator
- Involvement with tech plan for school/district
- 25 hours opening/closing schools
- **Collaborative** Action Research- two years
 - 25 hours

- Complete special district assignments
- Plan/manage school/district activities
- Author school/wide newsletters

The ABC's – 26 ideas

- Serve as Whole School Reform Facilitator
 - Serve on Site Based Management Team
 - Serve as office in professional associations
 - Author publications-state, national
 - Participate in cohort leadership activities
 - Experience reflective conversations with mentor/principal
