SCH stands for student credit hours. The student credit hours for a course are calculated by multiplying the number of credits a student earns for the course by the number of students in the course. Therefore, a 3-credit course with an enrollment of 25 students would generate 75 SCH's. Due to differences in timing, the figures in this table are slightly different from those presented in Table 2.15.

Enr stands for enrollments at the departmental level (across all classes). As a duplicated headcount, a student who takes several courses is counted as enrolled multiple times.

*This category includes enrollment, SCH, and section counts for exchange, first-year seminar, liberal studies (H&SS), liberal studies (S&H), and social science honors. In fall 2018, SCH counts are as follows: exchange: 12; first-year seminar: 1610; social science honors: 156; liberal studies (H&SS): 512; liberal studies (S&H): 27.
