

**Addendum to
3+1 Comprehensive Partnership Agreement between

The purpose of this addendum is to incorporate additional information into the Three Plus One Comprehensive Partnership Agreement between **Mercer County Community College** and **William Paterson University**. This addendum details the transfer of students enrolled in the associate's degree in Liberal Arts offered by the Liberal Arts Division at **Mercer County Community College** into the baccalaureate degree in Psychology program offered by the Department of Psychology at **William Paterson University**.

Year 3: Courses will be selected in consultation with a WP advisor. Course must include: all required pre-requisites to the Psychology major, directed electives, foreign languages, and two psych courses other than Intro that will transfer as an upper level requirement or an elective within the psychology major. Other courses in the third maybe those that will count toward a WP minor.
