I. PURPOSE

This policy sets tuition for new undergraduate and graduate students from Puerto Rico who were adversely affected by Hurricane Maria in October 2017, and permits room grants to those students, effective Summer Sessions 2018.

II. ACCOUNTABILITY

Compliance with this policy lies with the Vice President for Enrollment Management and the Office of Admissions (Undergraduate and Graduate), the Bursar's Office for billing purposes, and the Office of Residence Life for the administration of room grants.

III. APPLICABILITY (optional)

This policy applies to new undergraduate and graduate students from Puerto Rico who were affected by Hurricane Maria in October 2017. This policy is in effect for the time the students are enrolled at the University. The in-state tuition policy will be valid for one year subject to review in May 2019 to determine if it should continue to apply to any new incoming student in fall 2019. Students in this category may also be eligible for room grants depending upon the selection and criteria processes established by the VP for Enrollment Management.

IV. POLICY

For new entering undergraduate or graduate students from Puerto Rico affected by Hurricane Maria beginning summer 2018, the University will charge in-state tuition for the time the student is an enrolled student at WPU. This policy is in effect for the time the students are enrolled at the University. The in-state tuition policy will be valid for one year subject to review in May 2019 to determine if it should continue to apply to any new incoming student in fall 2019. Students in this category may also be eligible for room grants depending upon the selection and criteria processes established by the VP for Enrollment Management.
