



## Talent Development and Innovation in Sciences (TDIS) 2025 Summer Internship Program



### QEM TDIS Internship: A Full-Time, Paid, 10-Week Program

- Students will work remotely with NSF Program Directors on funded projects, explore career paths, and get insights into science policy.
- Travel is required twice: first, for an 8-day orientation in Washington, DC, and Alexandria VA, and then for 3 days for final presentation preparations and closing ceremony. All travel, lodging, and per diem expenses are covered.

#### Benefits

- A taxable stipend of \$6,000 for undergraduates and \$7,000 for graduate students
- An extra \$1,200 to attend STEM-related conferences and/or membership fees for STEM professional societies.

#### Eligibility

- Must have completed at least the sophomore year and majoring in STEM from an accredited college or university
- Graduating seniors must be entering graduate school in the fall.
- Must be a US Citizen or National of the United States
