2022-2023 Summary of Activities: The Council has met five times between October 2022 and March 2023 and made progress on the following:

- The Council reviewed two proposed policies from the administration:
 - The administration's draft language for the Academic Integrity Policy approved by the Senate last year; and
 - A new proposed Transfer Credit Policy

and provided feedback to the Senate. The Transfer Credit Policy was presented to the full Senate at its meeting on February 28, 2023 and approved by Senate vote.

- The Council met with a representative of the Governance Council to assist with its report on the alignment of Council Standing Charges in the Bylaws, on the Senate website, and within various Senate documents.
- The Council commenced work on its priority charges by compiling an inventory of all academic policies and their current status/availability. This inventory was based in the first instance on the "Academic and Related Regulations" section of the final printed Undergraduate Catalog [2008-2010] and identified 26 specific policies. This work will continue next year.
