Welcome back! I hope you had a great winter break! For those of you returning to WP, we are glad to have you back as you continue your journey to the graduation stage. For those new students who are just joining our community, we encourage you to make the most of your time here. I am counting on you to make this your best year yet at WP. We are here to support you every step of the way.

I invite you to review this important information below:

- Please remember to complete your Online Veteran Enrollment Certification Form to receive your full Education Benefits.
- Your first VA Post-9/11 payment for the spring semester will be on February 1st, but it will be prorated to the number of days from the beginning of classes until the end of the month: January 17th to January 31st. You won't receive the full amount until the next payment on March 1st.
- Last day to change your spring schedule, add or drop classes is January 23rd. Take in consideration that if you are a recipient of the Post-9/11 GI Bill and want to receive your complete monthly housing allowance you need to be a full time student (undergraduate 12 credits or more, graduate 9 credits or more) and physically attend $\frac{3}{4}$ in person classes.
- **January 26th**— Last day to request a pass/fail or audit option for a Spring class. Please contact the Registrar's Office for more information.
